

Health Services Research

AMGA works with members on studies addressing complex and resistant challenges in care delivery and population health. Our studies are carried out by AMGA members who benefit by translating evidence into achievable, measurable, sustainable, and scalable outcomes for successful application in practice settings. Members use implementation science to identify core elements that lead to successful interventions, increase widespread use of new evidence, and improve patient outcomes. Project advisors are highly respected practitioners and scientists. AMGA provides stipends for member participation.

- Data-Driven Insights: Accelerating Change and Improving Health: Leveraging our access to large, longitudinal clinical (EHR) and claims data across multiple health systems, AMGA enables discovery of trends and clinical opportunities often hidden to individual healthcare organizations. We use statistical techniques and computational approaches to accurately develop predictive models that forecast which patients are at the greatest risk for specific conditions or outcomes. For AMGA's campaigns and quality initiatives, we use data to identify positive outliers that inform quality improvement interventions and provide benchmarking and data support to members. AMGA works with preeminent national quality leaders to develop, test, and implement quality performance measurement so that payment incentives align with and are relevant to clinical practice and improvements in population health.
- AMGA Research Peer-Reviewed Publications: AMGA advances members' knowledge and experience through AMGA research by publishing our findings in peer-reviewed, scientific, and professional journals, furthering the exchange of practice-based scientific progress.
- AMGA Research Scientific Posters: AMGA's research posters provide relevant and timely research results in a simple, visual format. Posters are quick, useful tools for educating clinicians, clinic staff, and patients.
- AMGA Research Interest Group (RIG): AMGA's RIG includes researchers, practitioners, and others who share a professional or personal interest in the implementation and study of evidence-based methods to accelerate improvements in healthcare delivery and population health. Members learn about opportunities to collaborate and participate in AMGA research initiatives and tap into the collective health services research knowledge and expertise of AMGA members and research staff for shared learning. 
Rise to Immunize®

Rise to Immunize® (RIZE) is AMGA Foundation's third national campaign and aims to empower medical groups and health systems to collectively administer 30 million vaccines by 2027 through comprehensive and equitable vaccine initiatives. This six-year initiative focuses on increasing rates of seven critical immunizations—influenza, pneumococcal, Td/Tdap, zoster, RSV, COVID-19, and hepatitis B—among adults to decrease vaccine-preventable disease and death.


Through our efforts, members are assured that their interests are represented before many audiences, including Congress and federal agencies, in addition to other healthcare organizations and interest groups.
