Choose two or three opportunities to support vaccination in your practice (shown on next slide)





Spotlight: Ballad Health



During Ballad Health's RIZE Action Month meeting, the team reviewed their immunization performance and discussed utilizing messaging to close care gaps.

They also discussed working with their system pharmacy to hold vaccination rodeos in offices to catch-up patients.



Spotlight: Utica Park Clinic





Utica Park Clinic discussed continuing their drive-thru clinics for flu and pneumococcal vaccines, among other timely topics.

To prepare for flu season, they plan to review standing orders with medical assistants in the clinic.

Spotlight: St. Elizabeth Physicians





St. Elizabeth Physicians discussed two steps to improve immunization rates: assess current vaccination status and motivate patients to get vaccinated.

To assess their vaccination status, they spoke about utilizing the state's electronic immunization registry to keep track of externally administered vaccines.

To motivate patients to get vaccinated, they discussed emphasizing the importance of vaccination to minimize hospitalizations.

Spotlight: Norton Medical Group






Norton Medical Group's first Spanish-English bilingual clinic participated in RIZE Action Month this year!
