The NAIIS is dedicated to addressing and resolving adult and influenza immunization issues and improving the use of [vaccines recommended by CDC’s Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices](#). The NAIIS consists of over 700 partners, representing more than 130 public and private organizations. Broad-based leadership of the NAIIS is conducted through the members of the Summit Organizing Committee (SOC).

Meetings of the Summit

NAIIS members have traditionally met in-person at annual Summit meetings to update partner organizations on issues regarding the implementation of CDC’s Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) vaccine recommendations and to identify actions that NAIIS members can take to improve vaccine implementation. These in-person meetings are referred to as “Summit meetings.” These meetings are a great way to expand vaccination expertise for healthcare providers and staff.

The Summit also conducts weekly update meetings on Thursdays at 3PM ET. These meetings have moved from a phone-based meeting to a Zoom format following the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic and have taken on a more substantial role in providing information to Summit partners.

Meeting format and content
